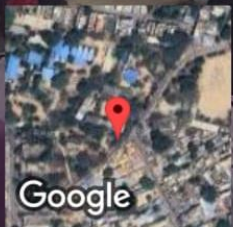

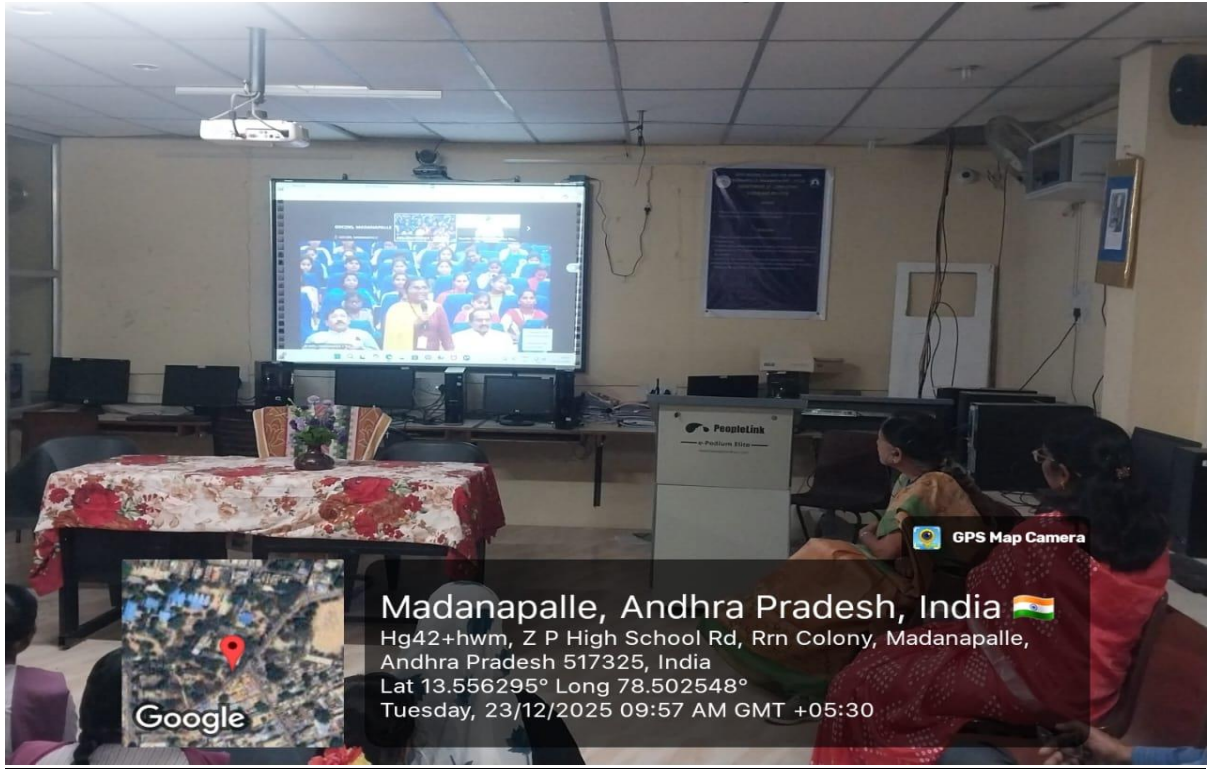

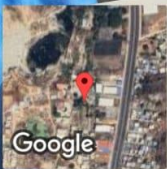
Social Service by Scouts and Guides

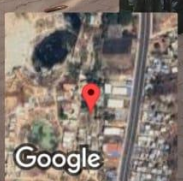
