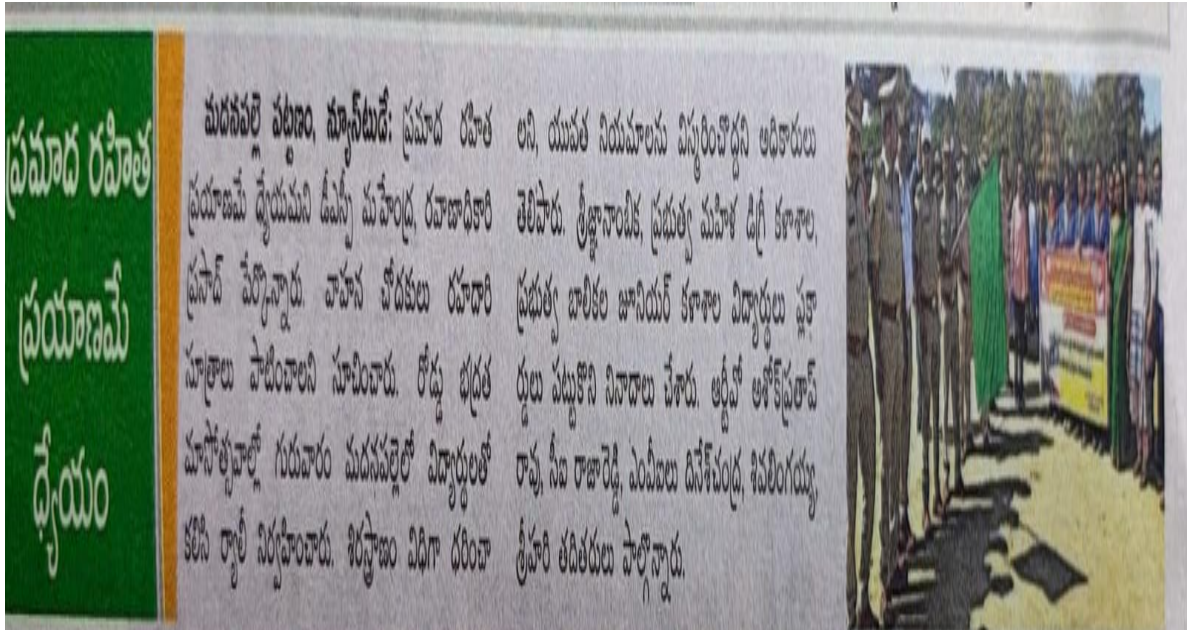


RALLY ON ROAD SAFETY

- **Awareness Program:** Informative sessions educated participants on how to vote responsibly and the role of voters in shaping governance.

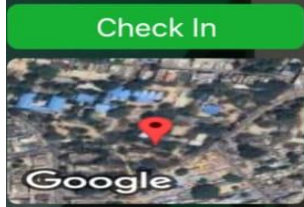
The event was a vibrant display of civic engagement, fostering a sense of responsibility among students and staff to participate actively in democratic processes.
