Student Achievements:

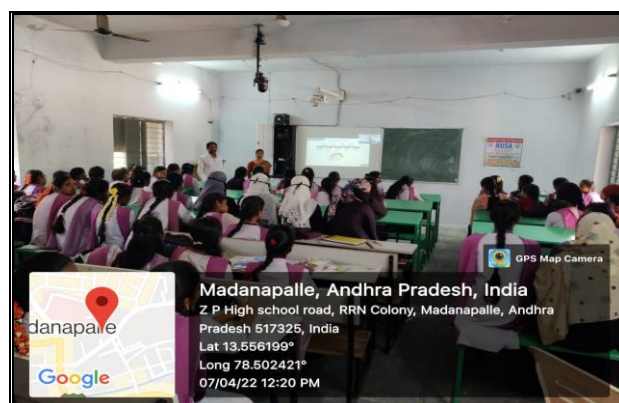
