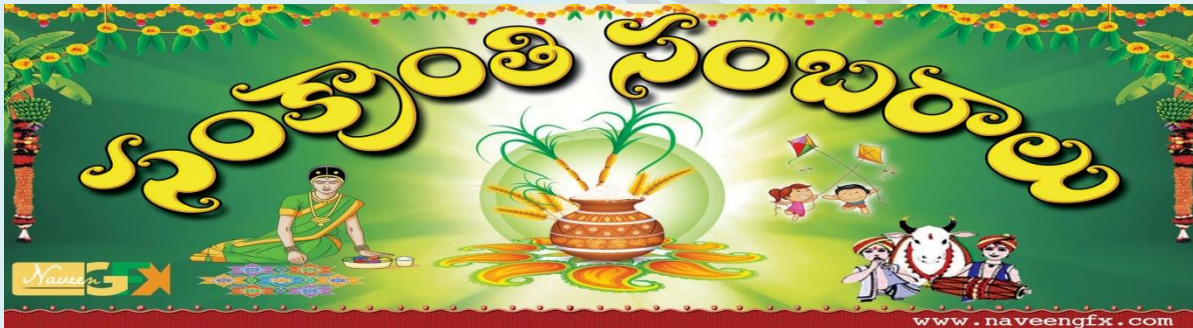

The Sankranti festive mood has set in in hundreds of villages in Chittoor and Annamayya districts. The rural side is getting ready for Bhogi on January 14, followed by Sankranti and Kanuma.

The traditional "Giri Pradakshina" ritual will be observed at various places at Puttur, Nagari, V. Kota, and Punganur in the third and fourth weeks of this month. Various streets in Chittoor town wear a fresh look with whitewashed houses. The Kuppam re-

gion is famous for the bull races, which come as an inferior version of Tamil Nadu's roaring Jalikattu. The villagers maintain that these bull races are organised peacefully.

Meanwhile Annamayya district observes the 'Kanuma Panduga' peacefully. The farmers limit the festival to decorating the cattle, painting their horns and smearing their heads with turmeric and 'kumkum', besides offering them specially prepared dishes. While Rayachoti division observes the cattle festival on 19, Madanapalle division observes it on 16.
